July was a good month for income with 2100.40 in group donations (thank you to all of the groups who donated), 22.00 from MBI 7th tradition collection, and 165.00 from our first retreat entry (more to follow, I’m sure). A list of groups who donated in July follows this report.

Our expenses were for the most part the usual monthly costs: office rent, donation to the hospital for MBI meeting space, paying Pat our wonderful office worker, phone/internet, website, webmaster. Extras this month were 250 each to WSO and R6 for our quarterly donations, \$35 filing fee to Mass. for our non-profit form (we don’t pay taxes as 501(c)3 non-profit but we need to prove our status each year), and \$100.00 to renew our petty cash fund at the office which is used primarily for postage (and yes, Pat does send all of the receipts to back it up), so we spend around \$100 each year on postage for packages and large envelopes.

Upcoming in August will be our accountant’s bill; August is usually pretty quiet.

September has the convention in Boston, and R6 Assembly later in the month. October will have our retreat, the R6 intergroup officers training the weekend after, and we will send another set of donations to R6 and WSO.
